**Water Quality Permit Compliance
Acknowledgement Form**

Applicability

Water Quality Permit is required for the following construction projects:

- Any job that results in a disturbance of 250 CF or more of soil or hard surface and/or 250 SF of flat work (i.e. pavers, concrete).
- Any job that requires outside stockpiling and/or processing of dirt or cementitious materials in front of the property.
- Any job that has a potential impact on water quality.

Applicant shall complete and submit a Water Quality Inspection Form / Inspection Notification with payment of \$238.85 (Permit Fee). **In the event of an anticipated heavy rain event (HRE), the applicant is responsible for opening any of his or her covered catch basins prior to the HRE in order to prevent flooding. After the end of the HRE, catch basins must be covered again to remain in compliance with the water quality permit.**

Inspection

- All projects with Water Quality Permits require a Water Quality Inspection by a City Inspector prior to the start of any construction work.
- To request an inspection, fill out the Water Quality Permit Form / Inspection Notification and indicate the day and time when the site will be ready for a water quality inspection. You can also contact (949) 425-2536 to schedule the water quality inspection.

Note: All required pollution prevention Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be in place prior to conducting a Water Quality Inspection

Enforcement

- Failure to comply with the Water Quality Permit requirements will result in a Notice of Non-Compliance, or with a Stop Work Order and may result in the issuance of an Administrative Citation according to the City’s Code Enforcement Policy.
